The "Why" of Ministry

As we enter the Christmas and New Year Holiday Season, in the church world, we celebrate these holidays as a time of "new beginnings." Of course, the greatest example of this "new beginning" is the birth of the Christ Child. In Him all things are made new. We also use this season as a time to decelerate from our hectic lifestyles, reflect upon and evaluate the effectiveness of our current ministries, and begin to formulate ministry plans for the coming year.

As we begin to evaluate the need for and the effectiveness of our ministries, I want to encourage each of us, as members of Trinity Baptist Church, to ask and honestly answer the "why" question. Why do we do a particular ministry? Secondly, I want to encourage us to ask and honestly answer the question: How effective is it? And if we cannot validate the "why" and the effectiveness of a particular ministry, then perhaps we should consider making some changes, or allowing it to die a very needful death. Doing so would allow us to devote our time, ministry resources, and efforts toward ministries that are helping us "flesh-out" our ministry purpose, as started in our current Bylaws.

Our Bylaws state that we are to:
"Win the lost, disciple the saved,
and minister to people in Jesus
name." Sadly, I am afraid that all
too often, in way too many
churches, us included, the only
reason some ministries continue
to exist - is because they have
always existed. However,
longevity does not equate to
effectiveness or need.

November 29th, 2023, I preached a sermon in which I mentioned that Matthew 4:17 records where Jesus preached a nine-word sermon: "... Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." In only nine words Jesus identified both the "what" and the "why" of His sermon. The "what" is to bring people to repentance. The "why" is because the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand. Generally speaking, people don't embrace the "what" of anything, especially ministry, until they understand the "why." Perhaps we need to refocus on the "why" of the ministry Jesus has called us to do, in order to better accomplish the "what!"

If God allows me to live until January 1, 2024, and you allow me to continue serving you, I will start my third year as your pastor.

I would be less than honest if I told you these first two years have been all "peaches and cream." You know differently! These first two years, as good as they have been in some areas, have also been very turbulent in others. It's been a time of serious adjustment for me as a pastor and for you as a church! However, I have never been more sure that I am where God wants me - as I am right now. As I stated in the sermon I preached on November 26th, "I'm in it to win it!" and 'I didn't hear no bell; one more round, one more round!""

So, what is the "take away" I want you to have from reading this article today? It's simply this:
As you decelerate this December and enjoy the Christmas and New Year holidays, and all that goes with them, take some time to reflect upon and evaluate the ministries of Trinity Baptist Church and begin to formulate future ministry plans.

To this end, it is my intention to lead us through a study based upon the book: "Simple Church.
Returning to God's Process for Making Disciples" by Thom Rainer & Eric Geiger. We have copies at the church for \$10 each. I encourage you to purchase a copy and be prepared for this study!
